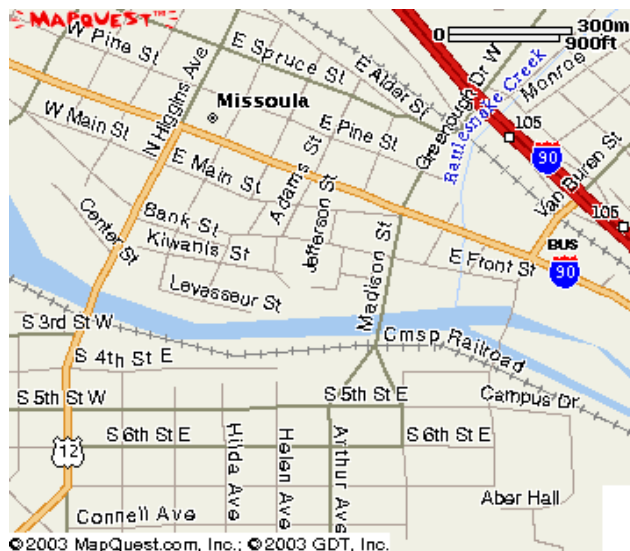


DIRECTIONS TO THE TRACKING SITE: From I-90: Take exit 105 onto Van Buren Street, go 0.29 miles merging into the right lane. At the stoplight, turn right onto Broadway (business I-90), go 0.32 miles. Move into the farthest left lane and turn left onto Madison Street at the stoplight. Drive over the bridge, stay in the left lane, and veer left at the fork in the road, you are now on Arthur Avenue. After the fork, keep to the left and turn left at the stoplight onto 6th Street. You will be heading east; continue straight 2 blocks and directly in front of you will be the Adams Center. Follow road left around the Adams Center to stop sign. Turn right at the stop sign onto Campus Drive. Follow road as it curves around Washington Stadium and turn left into Parking lot "U".

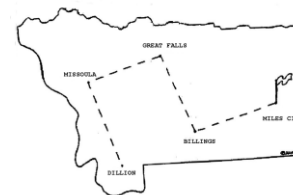

At Beckwith & Arthur (SW campus), take Arthur south to South Ave, turn left to Brooks (big intersection), left into far right lane to next light (short distance), turn left back onto South Ave, right on Reserve, a few blocks on your right to vet

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

Entry fees are \$125.00 (US funds). All entry fees include a \$.50 AKC Recording Fee and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. Fees must accompany all entries. Make checks or money orders payable to **BSTCM and mail entries and fees to BSTCM, c/o Kristina Hurley, 1745 S 14th St. West, Missoula, MT 59801**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly.

Entries must be made on an official American Kennel Club entry form that includes the Agreement. Do NOT send entries by any method requiring a signature for delivery

ALL CANCELLATIONS of entries must be made in writing to the Test Secretary and received prior to the stated date and time of closing entries.

CLOSING DATE: 12:00pm MDT, Thursday, August 4, 2011 at 1745 So. 14th St. West, Missoula, MT 59801.

DRAW FOR ENTRIES: A random drawing will be held on Thursday, August 4, 2011 at 1:15pm MDT at SHEC, 1919S. North Ave, Missoula, MT, in front of the main office door. The public is invited. Entrants will be notified by phone and/or e-mail as soon as possible after the draw. Nonparticipating alternates' fees will be returned shortly after the test.
